

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **DO YOU ALLOW PETS IN THE TASTING ROOM?**

Due to the fact that we're a production facility, unfortunately pets are not allowed inside. Service animals are allowed, but must remain with handlers at all times.

### **IS THE TAPROOM KID-FRIENDLY?**

We love kids of all ages at DC Brau! Bring the whole family. We have snacks & board games to keep them entertained.

### **CAN I BRING IN OUTSIDE FOOD?**

Sure! We typically have a food truck on site on Saturdays during growler hours and during special events, and we carry a selection of snacks from local producers that are available for purchase, as well.

### **DO YOU FILL GROWLERS LARGER THAN 64 OUNCES?**

We can fill up to a gallon (128 oz) growler in the tasting room for an extra charge (approximately \$10-\$15 more depending on the beer).

### **WHAT KINDS OF GOVERNMENT-ISSUED IDs DO YOU ACCEPT?**

- ▷ A valid photo driver's license issued by the DDOT or by any state
- ▷ A valid photo identification card issued with the DDOT or by any state
- ▷ A valid US government or armed forces identification card or Common Access Card (CAC) containing the holder's photograph and DoB
- ▷ A valid passport, passport card or travel visa containing the holder's photograph

### **WHEN ARE TOURS?**

Currently we only offer tours to the public on Saturdays from 1pm to 4pm at the top of the hour. Tours are free, and you must be wearing closed toe shoes for safety reasons to participate.

### **DO YOU ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS?**

Yes, we do! We accept all major cards and cash. No personal checks or money orders, please.

### **HOW OFTEN DOES THE DRAFT LIST CHANGE?**

Great question! It depends largely on demand. We typically have our flagship brews and a seasonal or two along with an occasional taproom exclusive.

### **IS THERE PARKING AVAILABLE AT THE BREWERY?**

Parking is available in our private lot. DC Brau, its staff, and our property owners and management company are not responsible for accidents or vehicle damage incurred on site or in the lot.

### **WHAT'S THE CLOSEST METRO STOP?**

The Brookland-CUA (red line) stop is approximately 2 miles away.
